

Adobe Reader Read Out Loud Warm Up

Many long non-commercial (homemade) PDF Electronic Books will not load the Read Out Loud function quickly and easily.

To assist the program, open a simple PDF file (like this one) with the free Adobe Reader program and activate the Read Out Loud function, before opening the Electronic Book.

This simple file will help the Read Out Loud function to completely activate.

Open this file on your computer with Adobe Reader.

Click the View Menu; Read Out Loud; Activate Read Out Loud; then click on the beginning of the text. After one line has been read, click View; Read Out Loud; Read to End of Document, and allow the read out loud function to flip through the simple pages.

Once complete, close the Warm Up file (File; Close) and open (File; Open) your non-commercial (constructed by happy amateurs) Electronic Book. Click View; Read Out Loud; Read to End of Document, to allow the Read Out Loud function to read to you.
